Joshua J. Beanblossom was a native of Laconia. He was born January 25, 1989, the son of Glenn and Tammy Beanblossom. He had one sister, Felicia. He was actively involved in Harrison County 4-H for 6 years as a member of the Kornfield County Kids 4-H Club. "He was skilled in building beautiful furniture," said his father. He loved to play video games, go bowling, fishing, and he enjoyed movies and amusement parks.

"Josh was a kind hearted person, that would do anything for anybody," said his mother. "Josh is missed very much by his family and friends."

Joshua died November 23, 2005 in an automobile accident at the age of 16.
